NOTES

All membership fees will be used to develop VbE practice and resources. Additional resources will be provided to members throughout their membership, with notification via our social media feeds. The level of additional resources will depend on the number of members. The availability of some benefits, such as training, is variable depending on programmed activity. The VbE Impact Survey is expected to be available from 1 October 2016.

Where applicable, VAT and trainers' travel, hotel and other direct costs of providing services is charged in

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addition to the above charges.

The savings above are based on purchase of the resource pack, the student/staff award schemes, 1 survey, 2 quality mark assessments, 1 school development day inset, 4 people attending each of the public conferences and members-only conferences, using the public conference charges for the equivalent of non-members attendance at members-only conferences. 1 professional development twilight session and 1 subscription to VotesforSchools.

Members Resource Pack

A selection of VbE resources, including the VbE e-Folder; VbE e-Manual; Values newsletters; resources to support parental engagement; assemblies packs; ideas for VbE displays.

VbE Impact Survey

The Impact Surveys helps school assess the impact of VbE at their school. Students, staff, governors and parents contribute towards a survey of benchmarked progress in VbE. It can be run as a survey, using a sample or the full population, or as a discussion to collate thoughts and experiences. We recommend the survey is carried out annually to allow regular monitoring of the effectiveness of a school's VbE practice.

VbE Student and Staff Award Schemes

The Student Award scheme is a structured framework for students to carry out values-related activities in and out of school. Once completed, the school can download a VbE-badged certificate to present to each student. The Staff Award scheme is a set of criteria and evaluation forms for staff to gather evidence of their contribution to the school's values environment. VbE-badged certificates can be downloaded for formal presentation.

VbE Staff Quality Mark Assessment

The staff Quality Mark assessment offers independent recognition of a staff member's outstanding contribution to the awareness and experience of students' positive, universal values and to the values environment within the school. It is the staff equivalent to a school's Quality Mark Award. This involves a visit by a VbE Consultant to the school to assess teachers' standards, and where appropriate, the formal award of a VbE Quality Mark of Professional Standards (for teachers) and of Values Inspiration (for support staff).

Members-only VbE Networking/Conference

The annual conference is open to members only. It provides updates on the latest developments in VbE, and opportunities to network with other schools and teachers, to share VbE ideas and to discuss joint initiatives. It is hoped schools will bring along between 3-10 staff members to reaffirm VbE concepts, reinvigorate staff with new ideas and expand awareness of how other schools implement VbE.

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VbE School and Staff Professional Development Training

A number of training days are being planned, that can be run either as public conferences or as school insets. They include VbE training, staff inductions to VbE, raising school standards, introduction of VbE to parents and many more.

Commended Third Parties

We work with a number of third parties who carry out activities that we commend to VbE schools. We believe their activities enhance the impact of VbE in developing an array of students' personal competences. It helps them to engage effectively with others at school and for the rest of their personal and working lives. Some of the third parties offer a discount to VbE members.
